SUNDAY

THE CHURCH GATHERED



WORSHIP

Pray against any tactics of the enemy that would seek to distract people from entering into worship.

Pray for anointing on the worship team and sensitivity to the Holy Spirit as they lead.

Pray for a multiplication of musicians and technicians as we prepare for live streaming.

Pray that our gatherings would be marked by a collective passion for the Presence of God.

Pray that our hearts will be open and expectant as worshippers.

Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in Truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. **John 4.23**

SUNDAY

THE CHURCH GATHERED

WORD:

Pray for an anointing on those who minister, preach and lead at Beacon Church.

Pray that people's hearts will be receptive to the Word whenever it is preached and for a willingness to respond.

Pray for the Holy Spirit to bring revelation and understanding through the preaching of the Bible.

Pray against any distractions or resistance to what is being preached.

Pray for all Beacon children and youth: that they will experience God's Presence and know His Word; that they will have their own revelation of Jesus Christ and choose to shape their lives around His truth and love.

GATHERING:

Pray for the power and presence of God to be manifest whenever we gather together, and for the gifts of the Holy Spirit to be at work.

Pray for a harvest of souls in 2024/2025—a marked increase in salvations in our services.

Pray for signs and wonders, including healings and miracles.

Pray for those who become Christians; that they would be filled with the Holy Spirit and become integrated into the church community.

Pray for those who recommit their lives to God; that they will quickly get connected back into church life.

Pray for joy and unity as God's people come together.

Stretch out your hand with healing power; may miraculous signs and wonders be done through the name of your holy servant Jesus.' after this prayer, the meeting place shook, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit. then they preached the word of God with

boldness. Acts 4:30-31

MONDAY

HEALTH & PROTECTION



Pray for the overall health and strength of God's people and anyone else you are praying for. Declare that every part of their body will function as it was designed to function and that they will live a long and healthy life. Where there are known health challenges, command all sickness to leave the person.

Pray for full health and strength to return to their body and/or mind.

Pray for those who are unwell that they will know the Presence of Jesus with them in their suffering.

Pray for those who are caring for someone who is mentally or physically unwell. Ask the Lord to give them strength, grace, patience and faith and for the Lord to help them to know His Presence sustaining them.

Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. **Matthew 6:13**

Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well. **3 John 2**

MONDAY

HEALTH & PROTECTION



Pray that our lives will be blessed, having a rhythm of work and rest so that we will be full of energy and vitality to serve the Lord.

Ask God to lead you away from temptation and to deliver you from evil.

Pray for God's supernatural protection over His people – that they will be delivered from all harm, and that all plans of the enemy will come to nothing. Declare that we are living under God's supernatural protection and that we will enjoy safety and peace.

Pray for protection over Beacon Church, from any attacks, distractions and false accusations, that the ministry would continue to advance with strength for the glory of God.

If you make the Most High your dwelling – even the Lord, who is my refuge – then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent. For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways. **Psalm 91: 9–11**

SUSTAINING ESTABLISHED MINISTRIES:

Pray for resources and staff to strengthen our existing Ministries and maintain our facilities to serve more people effectively.

EMPOWERING EMERGING MINISTRIES:

Ask God to bless our discipleship efforts through small groups and pastoral care, helping more people find purpose and freedom.

Pray for protection, strength, and provision for our missionaries, and that their boldness will inspire our faith

PIRITUAL GROWTH



Pray that each person in Beacon church, from the youngest to the oldest, will have a desire to grow in God, to know Him more and to become more like Him.

Pray that everyone will be empowered by the presence and power of the Holy Spirit, being rooted in the love of Christ and filled with the fullness of God!

Pray that every believer in Beacon Church will grow in their identity as sons and daughters of the Father – knowing who they are and becoming more and more like Jesus.

Pray that God would bring us as a congregation to a greater level of maturity, becoming more like Christ.

Therefore, I urge you brothers in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God – this is your spiritual act of worship. Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your

mind. Romans 12:1-2

WEDNESDAY

SPIRITUAL GROWTH

Pray that each person will have an open heart before God, confessing their sin and choosing to live a life of obedience, holiness and intimacy with God.

Pray that each person will become truly free from the pain, habits and patterns of thinking of their old way of life

Pray that each person will have a (renewed) hunger for the Bible; that the Holy Spirit will enable them to understand it, use it to speak to them and empower them to do what it says.

Pray that as a church will we continue to have a passion for the Presence of God – worshipping and pursuing Him wholeheartedly.

And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him. Hebrews 11:6

Pray that we will be a people who are growing in courageous faith, daring to step out beyond our comfort zone in obedience to God, reaching wider to impact individuals and our town.

Pray that each person at Beacon would be open to share their life with others in Christ-centred community, helping one another to grow in God; connecting with church and small groups consistently.

Pray that as a church we would grow in spiritual momentum throughout 2024-2025.



THURSDAY

EFFECTIVE MISSION

Pray that we would all be bold in sharing Jesus and in praying with others that they might encounter Him for themselves.

Pray that our lives will cause those we meet to ask questions about Jesus and to want to know Him.

Pray for a 'season of salvation' and a 'harvest of souls' coming to Christ.

Pray that God would lead us into great impact – reaching the 'nations' in our midst locally and also reaching overseas.

Pray for the eyes of unbelievers to be opened; that they would see their need of salvation and come to repentance.



Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. **Matthew 28:19**

THURSDAY

EFFECTIVE MISSION

Pray for Beacon Church ventures, where we are reaching out with the Gospel, including Suffolk Wellbeing - our ministry to help those struggling with their mental and emotional health.

Pray into a season of multiplication at Beacon Church – that the Lord would help us and lead us to reach people for Christ.

Pray that we will be passionately engaged in meeting the physical and spiritual needs of those living in our town that the Holy Spirit would empower us to be caring, loving, generous, authentic and relevant.

Pray for kids and youth.

FRIDAY

PROVISION

FRIDAY

PROVISION

Speak protection and God's favour and blessing over jobs and businesses, declare that they will thrive and succeed.

Pray for creative ideas, wise strategies and the ability to make wealth for the Kingdom.

Pray by name for anyone you know who is looking for work at this time, that God would open up a new door of employment or another source of income.


Declare that we will be a people with courageous faith who will step out and trust God in the area of finance. Pray that we will have many testimonies of God's miraculous provision as we do this.

But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness and all these things will be given to you as well.

Matthew 6:33

Pray for all who are considering partnering with our vision offering: that God will provide 'seed for the sower and bread for food' for all those who have pledged with faith from the youngest to the oldest – so that all will be able to redeem what they have pledged.

Pray for diligence and wisdom for Beacon's finance team, leadership, and board of trustees, as they steward what is given at Beacon Church.



SATURDAY

RELATIONSHIPS

Pray for the consistency of God's people to meet and 'be' together on Sundays and at other times.

Pray that Beacon small groups and all other groups will enjoy powerful and transformational Christ-centred community where people can belong and grow in God together.

Pray that all those who call Beacon 'home' would join a small group and be connected to others in Christ-centred community.

Pray that those who are lonely would find a place to belong in God's family.

Pray for leaders that they would know God's grace, strength and protection as they lead and oversee.

Pray for God's blessing and protection over our relationships within the church.

Pray that the unity of the Spirit will be maintained and that we would be protected from anything that would seek to bring division within the church.

Pray that we would treat each other with gentleness, humility, patience and love. Pray for godly friendships to flourish and that we would spur one another on to grow in our faith.

Pray for wisdom for parents as they raise their children and young people – that their lives and relationships will encourage their children to love and serve Jesus.

SATURDAY

RELATIONSHIPS

Pray that in love, we would grow in understanding of one another especially as a diverse church with different backgrounds, cultures and generations.

Pray that we will grow as a church of all nations, being able to celebrate, champion and support one another as brothers and sisters in Christ, with generosity and grace.

Pray that God's people will be quick to forgive one another and resolve conflict where it exists.

Pray for any marriages that are in difficulty, for love and peace to be restored.

Speak over marriages that what God has joined together man shall not separate.

Pray for sexual purity in our relationships; for faithfulness within marriages and for those not married, that they would have strength, grace, and wisdom to live with purity.

Pray for families; including for healthy relationships between parents, grandparents and children

Pray that children and young people will grow up knowing that they are loved.
